**Ways and Means/Fundraising:** Organize and oversee fundraisers approved and voted on by membership. Funds are used for Senior High School Awards and to support the mission of PTSA.

**Wellness:** To promote the improvement of the health and well-being of our students by educating, supporting and empowering students and their parents to make healthy choices. This committee’s focus is to enhance awareness and encourage responsible decision making and promotes behaviors that support good health through sexually transmitted infections prevention, alcohol tobacco and other drug prevention, juvenile protection/safety and environment.
